The models entered:

#1 Must be built out of the box with instructions present.

#2 Antennas, rigging or other details cannot be added even if they were made from kit sprue plastic

#3 Panel lines and other details may be sanded off and or re-scribed.

#4 All entries must be Atlantis kit produced/released prior to July 4th 2020.
