

- "RULES OF ENGAGEMENT": GIFT "THEFT" EXCHANGE SVSM DECEMBER 2022 MEET
- 1. YOU MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN. So show up on time to register AT FRONT DESK
- 2. MAXIMUM THREE Gifts put in play by any ONE player present (Need not be a member to play this year)
- 3. MAXIMUM THREE TOTAL Gift **EACH** may be put in play by Member & Family or Member/their Guests.
- 4. MINIMUM RETAIL VALUE EACH GIFT must be 25 US dollars. LABELYOUR NAME ON GIFT
- 5. GIFTS IN ORDER TO PLAY must be reasonably pre wrapped, not outrageously "disguised" or otherwise camouflaged, so as to not take a person all night (that we don't have) to unwrap and continue our game.

Summer 2020 which saw a sudden outbreak of COVID within the very city of Texas which was about to host the IPMS Nationals, producing an abrupt cancellation...




There was plenty of food to be had on site from a kitchen, cold soft drinks, plenty of helpful staff.




At my arrival, a shocking lack of 1/72<sup>nd</sup> Scale SE Jets left me in First Place, but by close of Registration this was not the case.

Their awards were in full display all day (see at left)











1/48th SE Jet was nice variety and included the club's signature vehicle, the "Dragon Lady" in entries.
