Here we had one set, an F-14A in 1/48th, a UH-60 in 1/48th, and a bust of a Commander of a Tiger Tank in Hungarian theater.


(jet aircraft, rotary wing, figure)

We also had updates on upcoming events from Mick Burton, along with specific news about the finalized status regarding the old SVSM meet locale of MPD Community Room in the city of Milpitas. Details of that are covered elsewhere in this issue, regarding the September 2021 meeting.



Discussion was lively for a while on matters of the need for and scheduling of our traditional Auction, as Burton had met with several times while in Las Vegas at the NATS with our Contest Director VP. This in part due to the fact of current new limits of usage for the old meeting locale which we have a good deal of experience logged using for just that purpose, and last few years done in September. Due to the unique situation of having cancelled the SV Classic 7 already three times from scheduled dates,

Contest Director VP and former Contest Director Burton determined the current status of event did not warrant a rushed Auction to "fit with tradition" Even though the Game Kastle doesn't preclude us having an Auction at their facility, and the MPD is technically available, for all practical purposes there is no current pressing need for doing any of that in September and every reason to arrange for a sensible Auction in later months. Maybe at the Kastle and may be elsewhere. So that is where we have tabled further discussion with abeyance for September auction in 2021. There is movement to confirm a Spring 2022 date for SVC 7 at the usual
