# "Modelling A March of Time In Tribute"

#### Another Model Tale by Kent M. McClure

On 15 March, 1968, the penultimate episode of season two of "Star Trek" premiered the episode "Bread and Circuses". Written by Gene Roddenberry and Gene L. Coon, the story, in essence, revolved around a twentieth century parallel to ancient Rome, complete with gladiators and guards in ancient Roman garb.

#### Remember that premise.

Now fast forward to the year 2023, the real 2023. One of my favorite websites for looking at reviews of  $1/72^{nd}$  scale figures is "**Plastic Soldier Review**". Normally I use this website to investigate figures to incorporate into small scale armor or aircraft kits – with the occasional dabble into suitable wargaming figures.

A Russian company called Strelets do an extensive line of figures that include a number of sets that include "non-traditional" figure poses and topics. Such as Napoleonic troops in winter gear or soldiers on the march.

While looking at their range, the title "Roman Legion on the March" caught my eye. Going to their review page, I saw examples of the type of figures that I had been looking for – heavily burdened foot soldiers.

The type of soldiers who were known as Marius' mules.

A germ of an idea began to grow in my mind.

I looked through my stash of small-scale armor and found that I had the 1/76<sup>th</sup> scale JB Model of a M-113.

That sparked another dormant brain cell.






I remembered reading somewhere that in post war Italy, the police had used some AS.42 Saharianas painted in a shade of red known as amaranth red.

Well, the old brain cells got active, and the result is this little diorama tribute to "Star Trek: the Original Series".

In this world, this alternate timeline, Rome is the preeminent power. Their police force retains the old-style dress of the ancient Roman soldier.

However, some of their weaponry has been modernized. Hence, the M-113.

The engineering of their infrastructure is that of ancient Rome. Roads are massive concrete slabs, and the walkways are cobblestone.



The JB Model of the M-113 is, to put it mildly, an oversimplification of the M-113 designed more for gaming than serious modeling. It also is only  $1/76^{th}$  scale. But it produces the desired effect – it looks like a M-113.



To the "bathtub-style" hull you glue the running gear/thread assembly, drop on the "armored box", side skirts and rear plate, and you are ready to paint.





I picked 6 figures from Strelets set #M007, Roman Soldiers on the March. The centurion figure was from HaT set #8075, Imperial Roman Command. That figure has a peg in its left hand to hold a shield, but since I did not use the shield, I removed the peg.



One thing about the figures; they are made of soft plastic, not the polystyrene plastic used for model kits. Regular model glue does not work well on them.

They are also more susceptible to flash and, as a result, a little harder to clean up. Scraping tends to cause the plastic

to "fuzz up".

A sharp blade is definitely a necessity.

Once cleaned up, the figures need to be washed and primed before painting.

My favorite primer is either Tamiya or Rustoleum. I use acrylic paints on my figures as a basecoat.



Then, I use a wash called Citadel's Nuln Oil to provide the shadow effect, followed by drybrushing and a final coat of Testors Dullcoat.









I had picked out the base that I was going to use, and dropped in where I wanted the APC and the figures to sit.

I then penciled in where I wanted the road, the "sidewalk", and the terrain to be.

My ground cover of choice was DAP DryDex Dry Time Indicator Spackling.

It goes on pink and dries to an off-white color. Being spackle you can carve and sand it to your heart's content.

Placing the figures were a tad more difficult. I built up the groundwork to the height of the figures' bases, then "excavated" the base material. A drop of thick superglue affixed the figures to the base.

Only a small amount of spackle was then used to blend in the figure.



I used craft acrylic paint, choosing a very light grey for the road and a darker slate grey for the cobblestones.

To offset the "greynish" of the base, I added a portion of greenery to one corner. I used Woodland scenic over a darker green base coat. The finished product was given a dusting of AK Africa Dust Effects and everything was sealed with a coat of Testors dullcoat.

It was then that I noticed that my base had a distinct warpage to it. I went out to look for a picture frame that I could glue my base to, thereby hiding the warping.

I found a frame that was close to the correct size and sanded to fit. End result – my homage to ST:TOS.

# GAMES, TOYS & COLLECTIBLES is What The G.T.C Means, See This Excellent New Addition to Our Hobby Shop Community HOSTING A GUNDAM/GUNPLA CONTEST for NOVEMBER

Editor manages to get on over to see some of the fun bring you a look as well.

I was late in comparison arriving, as found David Balderrama, Mark, Max and D.J. Balderrama, Sim Coester, Eugenie and Randy Ray already well into enjoy of the event. That's Event Director & SVSM/Free Hornet Aaron Rhetta there on the right, talking things Gundam over with David and Mark Balderrama. Short while after, I met Free Hornet Chris Kaminaga and his son, who both had come from Fremont to enter this cool event (Aaron had Pizza and drink on offer too!)





Aaron had announced this new shop at an SVSM Meeting at MPD earlier in the year, but this event gave me prime incentive to find time to finally show up to visit.

Easy to find being it is right off of Santa Clara Street at Eighth St; full address is 18 So. 8<sup>th</sup> Street SJ with even some street parking at the front of the store! (If you are in Downtown SJ much, you likely know that's not exactly common)

As you will see, there is a definite lean into the extremely popular world of GUNDAM with the inventory here.

To help you gain an appreciation of just how much and how fast this hobby franchise has taken off, consider that it's "birth date" goes only as far back to April, 1979, in Japan

> That was when "Mobile Suit Gundam" TV series first launched and set up the parameters for this Japanese military science fiction media franchise

> One of those key tenets the series put in place is that of "real robots", basically mechanisms that are 'nt imbued with mythic super powers but are based in our physical world reality, so are prone to mechanical breakdowns, ammunition supply limits, humanoid operator fatigue, etc. Gundam are essentially humanoid driven mechanicals and although often complex, are rooted in reality.

Now a worldwide fanbase and currently spans across 50 TV series, films, manga and related media, as well as a huge plastic model basis.

Thanks to researching this subject recently, I am given to understand that in fact these days that plastic model kits industry basis for these comprise some 90 percent of the Japanese character plastic model market. Which is where the term "GUNPLA" essentially came from, being shorthand for "Gundam Plastic Model". Evolving mightily since the early 1980s, GUNPLA kits have grown to include several major gradations with increasing complexity, finish, means to articulate the model, detail, as well as several standardized scales. When you see the terms FG, MG, PG, RG, NG in show entries referenced as GUNDAM, those gradations are what are being noted. High Grade (HG) was apparently the first of these, introduced in 1990 and making 1/144 as a standard here with features formerly expected to be only in larger scales of Gunpla. Master Grade (MG) followed later with 1/100 as its standard scale, a 1/60 scale Perfect Grade




(PG) in 1998 set a very high bar which apparently has meant since only a few kits in this range, but apparently well worth the money for the kit basis.

Since the 2000s several other grades and scales have been introduced, some made to be economical fun introductions to the entire GUNPLA universe, others to reimagine prior editions or redevelop them for more complexity or limited specific complexity improvements or focused articulations. Interesting and complex to become familiar with them no?

.Now that I have perhaps given some of you a better idea what these models are, we'll get back to looking at this local Event. Above, a good look inside GTC, and note that's Chris Kaminaga, Fremont Hornet and contestant, on center left.


Perhaps a longer shot is in order, eh? Here you go, a better look at the well attended category. Keep in mind as well, the contest is underway but not done taking entries so more were coming
