Which simply translates when expanded: Build Back Better Subjects

Simple Rules:

The finished TWO models must be same scale and of same subject representative throughout

One must be an early build or a crude kit, the Other must be one you have done better

(OK in using a better kit to start with, for an example)

Examples given for Qualifiers:

A Revell P-39 Airacobra in 1/72nd scale & a Heller, Academy, ?? A Revell P-51D Mustang in 1/72nd scale & ALMOST ANY OTHER P-51D in 1/72nd A Lindberg Me-163 Komet in 1/72nd scale & ALMOST ANY OTHER Me-163 in 1/72nd A Monogram B-26 Invader in 1/67 scale & ALMOST ANY OTHER B-26 in 1/72nd An Airfix A-26 in 1/72 scale and an Italeri A-26 in 1/72 scale A Lindberg Arado AR-234 in 1/72nd scale and a Frog Ar-234 A Frog Ar-234 and a DML Ar-234 in 1/72nd scale
