"NOW A REMINDER ABOUT COUNTING DOWN THE DAYS & REFLECTIONS on CONTESTS OF WILL "

Took again longer than I desired to get issue out to press, life's like that I know, but time's constant pressure nonetheless So here's the deal in a quick review of last Editorial. As significant things have occurred since which make this month's upcoming meeting events all the more time critical. 2023 marks the 60th continuous year of operations for this outfit and now also marks the *first time* in *recent* years *we did not put on an open invitational* annual show which has been known as the Kickoff Classic and then more recently, the SV Classic, as by lack of will, not due to forces beyond our control as has been the case for last event which had to be cancelled four times over two years. My hats off again to Mike W & Bill F !

To repeat here what I have spoken publicly to the membership at meetings over 2023 when asked and wrote again here:

We on the E-Board have been asked several times over the past several months by various folks in various ways, when is the next SV Classic being held (expecting it to occur in 2023 of course). We have made it clear *there won't be one in 2023* when it became clear to us who comprised the initial exploration committee as noted in the October 2022 Election results, (President, 2nd VP, Treasurer). That we ourselves had no possible way to reasonably take up all required acceleration force, by the end of the first quarter of 2023. We also knew then that unless someone truly had "that fire in the belly, that Will to See It Happen", that irresisitible DYNAMIC inertia, to step in, step up, get her done, that inevitably, static inertia occurs.

As it happens, the Open position for 2022/23 1st VP/Contest Director chair remains officially unoccupied, however last month's meeting opened business with an announcement that 2022/23 Secretary Chris Bucholtz had launched initiative to volunteer to become a point person to get a possible 2024 SV Classic or similar event underway in time. That being said, we have now put together an official slate with everyone on it in agreement to serve together for 2023/2024 Board, that includes this post being filled, Chris being the proposed Officer there, and we have our Elections for October in plan

I will encourage everyone to show up who can, for the October SVSM meet at MPD on the 3rd Friday this month, so that we can conduct a swift business at hand, determine if any additional nominees wish to make themselves known for any Posts, and be done with getting the new Board into operations whomever it shall be constituted by, by end of meeting.

I don't at all foresee any issues hanging this plan up, only have wish to remind as I outlined last issue, the important arc here for the key post which remained unfilled for most of this year, as anyone else wishing to take it on needs to know:

Right now, our next Contest Director has to 1) find our new venue and contract it 2) Has to quickly as well secure a date not already in play or taken for 2024, and get it approved by Region Nine RC. 3) Have some idea who he/she can depend on to get Awards, Raffle Items, Vital Paperwork, Promotion Efforts, Vendor Outreach/Management underway pretty much simultaneously now 4) Come up with a theme suitable for our 60th year as a Chapter to go with all this. Now **I know Chris has item 4 secured, he is working on items 1, 2, 3, one helpful fact for him is he is the R-9 RC so bet should be cinch for Date approval.** I for one will be voting (selfish of me, I know) for the slate proposed on page 19 of this issue. See you in October *-fini mickb*

First: Quick review of the stated rules here for: CORVETTE SUMMER PART DEUX

There are more than one type of CORVETTE, this is 70th anniversary of the Chevrolet automotive model, which has C1-C8 versions current. Also encouraged to consider the concept cars eligible, there are kits available to make them. The ships, not quite as easy for some. The Part Deux ? Well, for one, SVSM has had this Club Contest theme in past, So, a repeat. Also, Fremont Hornets have now done it for their first time in July '23... so chance for them to try again



With pleasure, The Editor welcomed the second encounter with this Corvette, the Goodwrench racing team 2003 C5-R of **Bob Meyers**. Bob got this kit as a gift from his wife early in their relationship, started it enthusiastically he outlined.



Yet as life for modelers often has it, languished unfinished over the years.

When the July 2023 Fremont Hornets Club Contest given in honor of the 70th anniversary of this iconic American car came, Bob inspired to finish his model, done in red/white/blue 50th anniversary scheme (hence race #) as created for the LeMans 2003. He took a first place in the Hornets contest with this delight.

Bob noted at our event that he worked his magic touch with weathering on his build, something he may not have tried had he finished this years ago. Great !





Amusing in some ways for the coincident facts of it, this 1964 Sting Ray 'Vette is a "Shelf of Doom" kit as well. From the prolific plastic modeler of Region Nine and life member of SVSM, Fremont Hornets, Mr. **Cliff Kranz.** I have known him to set models aside over the years for good while. But this is first time I recall of ever knowing one he began at age 15, yet having never returned to since 1966 !

A rarity indeed, an MPC (Model Products Corporation) kit from its early days, an American model company founded in 1963 and quite prolific in its own time. Lasting into 1985 on its own, until acquired by ERTL, who had already taken its main rival AMT (Aluminum Model Toys). All three ended up later being acquired as brands of Round 2 LLC, which has quite a history of its own that thankfully preserves American modelling industry to this day. HAWK is also one of theirs!



Last entry of the evening before "registration closed (meeting begun)", but far from least, was this lovely from our current President. It was also the newest model of the three, and only one that wasn't a member of the Shelf of Doom club, wow!



Greg Plummer took this challenge up to have work anew for the Club Contest, with quite a passion.

He started with a R-M kit of a Thom Taylor custom, "Vette AGIN" (spoken as Vet Again, just FYI) and made it his own custom.

Greg lowered the model, put it on a modified VW Jetta frame, and gave it 24 inch wheels.

Covered with a custom mix paint and metallic blue flames, there you have it !










Her Title Tells It All So Well...




Part of all this why I am particularly taken with this, a splendid mix of my own quirks and an admiration for her ambition




