

The Field Of Battle As It Progressed

Finally Filled Out



Thanh Nguyen entered one of his many Tamiya A-1s, this one an A-1H in RVNAF markings from AoA Decals.



His Vietnamese SPAD is still awaiting its external armament, Thanh said.



(SPAD is an old USN nickname based on the original designation as AD-1 (Attack Douglas) through AD-7. Riffing WW1 French aircraft as the pilots were told how obsolete their old prop planes were. SP stood for Single Place)

Mark Balderrama brought in an A-10 Thunderbolt II, an F-14 Tomcat, a Eurofighter Typhoon, and a 3D-printed Kaman K-Max he made from his own drawings, including internal gearing that allows the interlocking rotors to spin in tandem with each other!



Mark cleared it with contest sponsor that the Eurofighter painted in super dark gray (essentially same shade as “NATO BLACK”)



The classic original Light Gull Gray and White scheme on F-14A Tomcat



Mark's 3D-printed scratchbuild K-Max in 1/144th captures all the bizarre but beautiful lines of the real Kaman twin rotor
D.J. Balderrama's USS *Iowa* in 1:700 scale.



D.J. got the Tamiya kit from his brother and has been kept busy by the many gun positions.

Ron Wergin's collection of Luftwaffe '46 models included a PM 1:72 P.13a and a Revell Flitzer, also in 1:72 plus a Revell 1:72 Messerschmitt P.1101 a plane that pioneered the idea of a variable-angle sweep to the wing (although it could not sweep the wing in flight). (it's actually a Messerschmitt P.1106, and unknown if Huma or AZ model, not a Revell)






Dr Alexander Lippisch definitely had an intrigue with tailless/delta aircraft. This P.13A was supposed to be a ram jet engined point defense interceptor, no armament as intent was to RAM with the strengthened wing leading edge



The Focke Wulf “Flitzer” (“Streaker or Dasher”) was pretty ambitious, 590mph with 2x30mm, 2x20mm cannon!

This is actually the Messerschmitt P 1106 design with a fixed wing. The P.1101 variable sweep is the small picture



Dave Balderrama with his gray alien, built from the Testors kit. He was quick to note that he used multiple shades of gray paint to get his alien to look more extraterrestrial life-like!



Apparently his paint job seemed to work a little too well as this scaly grey predator, despite clear not interested at all hand signals, closed in on the poor guy. Look, he's at the microphone trying to call for help and scaly is on him



I never learned who or what the tiny stranger on the white base was, but you can see they tried mightily to be of some assist. There was no sign of them later.

Then it dawned on me may all been a misunderstanding, as the scaly predator has this clamp on end of his tail mayhaps so just wanted to seek out help removing...

Then there is possibility this unknown entity, who came and went without permanent record , might have deployed the tiny stranger, we may never know, only these few pictures remain...





I did get one decent shot before entire craft vanished, so here's to **An Unknown Modeler**, well done basics here it seems

Mike Schwarze's superdeformed Godzilla, which was not exactly finished — his roommate “unfinished” it by breaking the tail off, which has been re-attached and the putty has been sculpted to match the original texture.

Mike plans on repainting the entire piece.


